Dear Judge McMahon:

I, the plaintiff in the above-referenced matter, respond herein to the Court's memo-endorsed Order dated November 13, 2025, which states, in full:

Mr. Bank's motion for reconsideration has been denied. There is no "motion for reconsideration of a motion for reconsideration." This case is closed. This court will take no further action. Mr. Bank knows how to file a notice of appeal if he wants the Second Circuit to review this court's discretionary decision.

In the motion that resulted in the above order, *i.e.*, the motion that you describe as a "motion for reconsideration of a motion for reconsideration," *i.e.*, Docs. 53, 54 (Nov. 12, 2025), I merely asked the Court to "correct[] errors of the *Decision and Order Denying Plaintiff's Motion for Reconsideration*, dated November 5, 2025 (Doc. 51), as set forth in the accompanying Memorandum of Law," Notice of Motion (Doc. 53), wherein I stated that the "*Decision and Order Denying Plaintiff's Motion for Reconsideration* (the 'Reconsideration Decision,' Doc. 51) . . . contains errors for which Bank seeks correction in the form of a new Decision that does not contain those errors." Pl. Mem. (Doc. 54) at 1. Thus, I did not ask the Court to reach a different result than it had in the Reconsideration Decision, *i.e.*, the denial of my one and only motion for reconsideration, *i.e.*, Docs. 49, 50 (Nov. 3, 2025), but only to correct the errors therein.

I continue to be struck at how dishonest, biased, and shameless you are. Would you blame me for wondering if something untoward is behind your unbecoming conduct?
